+ **NEXT SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, STARTING THE NARRATIVE LECTIONARY** Pilgrim will be trying out the Narrative lectionary as a way to encourage Biblical reading and reflection. An insert will be provided in addition to the sermon notes for use in household devotions and readings for each day of the week. The readings follows the church year and there is a 9-month/4-year cycle. Our preaching will sometimes follow this, but often the texts will simply stand alone in our worship gatherings. The newsletter insert connects Sunday to Monday and the rest of the week with a Bible reading plan that provides context and continuity to the Sunday readings. These devotional inserts guide households through the story of Scripture from creation to the early church over the course of nine months.

+ **SEPTEMBER 10, WORLD SUICIDE PREVENTION DAY (WSPD19)** Organized by the International Association for Suicide Prevention (IASP) and co-sponsored by the WHO, this day is to raise awareness around the globe that suicide can be prevented. In past years, over 300 activities in around 70 countries were reported to IASP, including educational and commemorative events, press briefings and conferences, as well as Facebook and Twitter coverage.
