

PARENTS: Our nursery is a safe environment available during our Sunday gathering for children up to 5 years old. We share a Bible story, games or art, and have creative free play; all taught by loving, caring individuals.

Our ministry to kids is just beginning! Please be a part of this ground breaking for a new generation! Every Sunday except the first, will have a time of worship, play, simple teaching, and conversation led by screened volunteers in a safe environment.



Our check-in station is set up and a Pilgrim Kids team volunteer will be available to register your child from 9:30-10:15 am each week in our foyer. If you are a first-time guest, we will give you a registration card to fill out so that when you return, there is only a quick check-in each week. Kids stay with parent/guardian during the music set and are released for the Pilgrim Kids! ministry time with our team. Kids remain in the fellowship space with our Pilgrim Kids team until the parent/guardian with the matching tag (only) checks them out.

+ TODAY! THE NARRATIVE LECTIONARY We will be using the Narrative lectionary as a way to encourage Biblical reading and reflection. An insert will be provided in addition to the sermon notes for use in household devotions and readings for each day of the week. The readings follow a 9-month/4-year church year cycle. Our preaching will sometimes follow this, but often the texts will simply stand alone in our worship gatherings. The newsletter insert connects Sunday to Monday and the rest of the week with a Bible reading plan that provides context and continuity to the Sunday readings. These devotional inserts guide households through the story of Scripture from creation to the early church over the course of nine months.

+ TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, WORLD SUICIDE PREVENTION DAY (WSPD19) Organized by the International Association for Suicide Prevention (IASP) and co-sponsored by the WHO, this day is to raise awareness around the globe that suicide can be prevented. In past years, over 300 activities in around 70 countries were reported to IASP, including educational and commemorative events, press briefings and conferences, as well as Facebook and Twitter coverage.
