

## HOME CHURCH GUIDE:

- CHECK-INS: Introduce, check-in
- CARE: Needs in the group
- COMPASSION: What is the group planning? Are you inviting your neighbours to join in?
- GROUP ANNOUNCEMENTS Church-wide and group-only
- DIG IN: "Breaking the Ice" question (group facilitator), discuss questions as a group
- PRAYER: Final questions, prayer huddles for personal requests. Consider breaking into small groups (huddles) of 2-4, by gender, if large enough.

## FOR REFLECTION AND DISCUSSION:

1. How does Paul use the images of a house and clothing in 5:1-5 to describe our future existence?
2. In what ways are you or those you know burdened by your present physical existence?
3. What does living by faith look like as opposed to living by sight or living by doubt (5:7)?
4. Paul has shared how the future resurrection relates to present suffering. How do the future resurrection and the words of this chapter help you face the present suffering in your own life that challenges your hope and heart?
5. Who is someone you can come alongside and encourage with these truths?

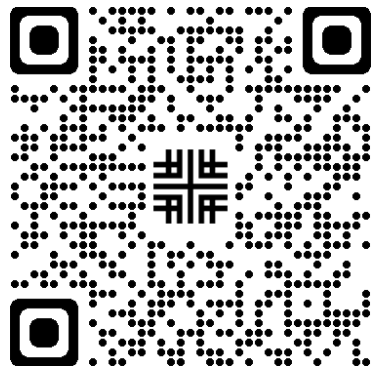
